Re: Guild Announcement to Guild Basic Training Graduates

Dear Guild Graduates,

The Guild for Structural Integration (Guild), based in Utah, and The Rolf Institute of Structural Integration ("Rolf Institute"), based in Colorado, have been in discussions regarding the Rolf Institute accepting graduates of the Guild as members of the Rolf Institute under certain procedures and requirements. Acceptance of all applications will be in the sole discretion of the Rolf Institute.

To be eligible to submit an application for consideration, Guild Basic Training Graduates must meet the following initial conditions:

- Graduate from the Guild Basic Training Program for Practitioners of Structural Integration and have been trained by former teachers appointed by Dr. Ida P. Rolf or teachers hired by the Guild. The offer does not apply to graduates of any other training program that uses the word "guild" in their title.
- Provide Guild transcripts and/or a copy of Guild certification and proof that the applicant was a member in good standing with the Guild prior to its dissolution.
- Complete additional documents as will be required by the Rolf Institute as part of the online application process.

The application process opens on **June 1, 2023**, and closes at midnight on **December 31, 2023**. Guild graduates who are interested in applying for Institute membership may access the online application [\[Here\]](#). Applications will be considered by the Rolf Institute within a reasonable time after the application is completed.

Acceptance of applicants to be members of the Rolf Institute is in the full and sole discretion of the Rolf Institute, and the Rolf Institute is not obligated to provide reasons for a decision not to accept any applicant as a member.

Nothing in this announcement constitutes permission or license to use the service marks of the Rolf Institute. Applicants whose application is accepted will be required to enter into certain agreements, including the Rolf Institute Membership Master Agreement and the Service Mark License Agreement and to pay prorated dues. Upon completion of these requirements, applicant will be granted membership in the Rolf Institute and granted a license to use the Rolf Marks, during the term of membership.
